

## The Almighty Father is our Savior and His name is Yahshua

The Old Testament tells us there is no Savior but the Father.

*I, I am Yahweh, and there is no other  
Savior but **Me**.*

Isaiah 43:11

*For there is no other God but Me, a righteous God and Savior.  
There is none but **Me**.*

Isaiah 45:21

*And you shall know no God but Me;  
For there is no savior besides **Me**.*

Hosea 13:4

The New Testament tells us Yahshua is the Savior

2 Peter 1:1

*To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the  
righteousness of our God and **Savior** Jesus Christ.*

Titus 2:13

*looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great  
God and **Savior**, Christ Jesus,*

2 Timothy 1:10

*but now has been revealed by the appearing of **our Savior** Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,*

1 Timothy 4:10

*For it is for this we labor and strive, because we have fixed our hope on the living God, **who is the Savior** of all men, especially of believers.*

John 4:42

*and they were saying to the woman, "It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves and know that this One is indeed **the Savior** of the world."*

The apostle Thomas cried out to Yahshua...

***"My Lord and my God!"***

John 20:28

Are we to believe that when Thomas proclaimed Yahshua to be "God" he was not proclaiming Yahshua to be **The Almighty Father?**

And, what about the apostle Paul, who called Yahshua...

***"our great God and Savior."***

Titus 2:13

And what about the apostle Peter who said...

***"To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ:***

2 Peter 1:1

Ephesians 4:6 tells us there is **“one God and Father of all”**. Since we know Yahshua is God, we know He is the Father.

Isaiah prophesied that the “Son” who was to come would be called **“Mighty God”** and **“Everlasting Father”**. (Isaiah 9:6)

**Philip asked to see the Father, not realizing who Yahshua actually was.**

In John 14:7 Yahshua told His disciples, “If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on **you know Him and have seen Him.**” Upon hearing this statement, Philip requested, **“Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us.”** (John 14:8).

Philip asked if Yahshua would **“show” them the Father** and then they would be satisfied. Yahshua seemed genuinely perplexed,

**“Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”**

Like many people today, Philip had not comprehended that **The Almighty Father** is an invisible Spirit and that the only way a person could ever see Him would be by seeing **Yahshua Messiah**, **“God manifested in the flesh”** (1 Timothy 3:16).

**“Have I been with you so long,  
and yet you have not known Me?”**

## **“God was manifested in the flesh”**

1 Timothy 3:16

The Apostle Paul wrote this.

Notice, Paul did **not** say,

“God’s son was manifested in the flesh,”

Paul was speaking of the One and only God, **The Almighty Father** being manifested in flesh.

The manifestation of The Almighty Father in flesh **was Yahshua MessiYah**.

**Yahshua MessiYah** was The Almighty Father **come in flesh**.

The Almighty Father manifested Himself in flesh, **as a human**, as our ‘**Kinsmen Redeemer**’, in order to **fulfill the demands of the Law on our behalf**. The Almighty Father did **FOR US** what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves!

Then, on the cross He took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon **Himself**, thereby making us **“holy, blameless”** and **“without a single fault”** in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)

**This is the gospel!**

**This is the Good News!**

*“He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities.  
For as high as the heavens are above the earth,  
so great is His love for those who fear Him;  
as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.”* David... Psalm 103:10-12

## Salvation is a **gift** for you

Salvation is a **gift** we receive when we call upon Yahshua MessiYah, *The Almighty Father manifested in flesh*. The **gift** of salvation cannot be earned by our deeds, works or fruitless *self-righteous* attempts at 'keeping the Law'. We cannot obtain it by being a "good person" or by attending church.

Yahshua earned it **for us** by dying for **our** sins on the cross.

*"For by **grace** you have been  
saved through **faith**,  
and that **not of yourselves**;  
it is the **gift** of God*

Ephesians 2:8
