

According to the 'Trinity Doctrine'
it is not possible for Yahshua Messiah to be 'I AM'

Scriptures **inarguably** show, 'I AM' is **The Almighty Father** (Exodus 3:14).

The Almighty Father appears to Moses

When **The Almighty Father** appeared to Moses in the burning bush, Moses asked His name.

The Almighty Father gave Moses this reply:

*"I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites:
'I AM has sent me to you.' Exodus 3:14*

Ever since this name was spoken by **The Almighty Father**, the Israelites considered the name "I AM" to be **sacred**.

This name was not to be used in vain or bestowed on **anyone** other than **The Almighty Father Himself**.

The Gospel of John tells us that one day the Pharisees came to question Yahshua.

Yahshua responded to their questions saying,

"I tell you the truth, before Abraham was born, I AM!"
John 8:58

Here, Yahshua calls **Himself** the sacred name of **The Almighty Father**, 'I AM'.

Yahshua proclaimed to them (*and us*) that **He** was **'I AM', The Almighty Father** of Exodus 3:14 that they *purported* to worship.

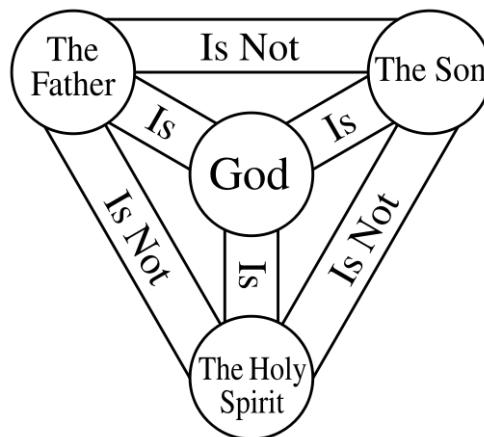
The Pharisees became enraged when Yahshua made the **proclamation** that **He** was **'I AM'** and they picked up stones to kill Him for blasphemy.

Sadly, there are many people today, who just like the Pharisees, **reject** our Savior's **own words** proclaiming **His identity** as being **'I AM', The Almighty Father come manifested in flesh**.

The 'Trinity Doctrine' states...

*"God exists as **three distinct persons**; **Each person** is fully divine."*

According to the 'Trinity Doctrine', "**The Father is not the Son**" and "**The Son is not the Father**"

Therefore, according to the 'Trinity Doctrine', **it is not possible** for Yahshua Messiah to be **"I AM"** because **Yahshua is the Son**; **Yahshua is not the Father**.
