

Look what we've missed since they removed **Yahweh's name** from the Bible

The Apostle Paul did **not** say Jesus is '**Lord**'; Paul said, Jesus is '**Yahweh**'.

'**Jesus is Lord**' is an often used phrase in the Christian world.

In Romans 10:9, The Apostle Paul told the Believers in Rome (**and us**) to confess **Jesus is 'Lord'** to be saved. The '**Old English**' word '**Lord**' however, is **not** the word that Paul used in this scripture.

The '**Old English**' word '**Lord**', when it refers to The Almighty, is the translation of the **Greek** word '**kurios**'.

The **Greek** word '**kurios**', is the translation of the **Hebrew** name '**Yahweh**'.

In truth, the Apostle Paul told the Romans that if they confessed '**Jesus is Yahweh**' and believed in their heart that God raised him from the dead they would be saved.

*If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord (**Yahweh**) and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, **you will be saved**. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.*

Romans 10:9-10

John the Baptist said, *"Prepare the way for **Yahweh**"*
