

There is only one 'I AM'

In the Old Testament, **The Almighty Father** proclaims that **He** is 'I AM' (Exodus 3:14). In the New Testament, **Yahshua Messiah** proclaims that **He** is 'I AM' (John 8:58).

Are there **two** 'I AM's?

No. **The Almighty Father** is the **only** 'I AM'.

The Apostle Paul gives us understanding.

Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 8:6, "**for us there is one God, the Father.**" Paul tells us again in Ephesians 4:6 there is "**one God and Father of all.**"

Paul then tells us our "**one God, the Father**", manifested Himself in flesh.

"God was manifested in the flesh"

1 Timothy 3:16

There is only one Great God

In the **Old** Testament **The Almighty Father** is called 'the **Great God**'.

In the **New** Testament the Apostle Paul calls **Yahshua Messiah** our **Great God**.

Are there **two** great God's?

No. **The Almighty Father** is the **only** 'great God'.

In Titus 2:13, the Apostle Paul **clearly identifies by name** who our **great God** and **Savior** is.

*"looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of **our great God** and **Savior** Jesus Christ"*
(Yahshua Messiah)

The Apostle Paul...Titus 2:13

The **invisible** Father in the Old Testament, became a **visible man** in the New Testament

The Bible tells us The Almighty Father manifested **Himself** in flesh as a man, to do for us what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves. He fulfilled the demands of the Law **as a perfect man of flesh**, so that He could be our perfect sacrifice, 'kinsman redeemer' and Savior.

On the cross He took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon Himself, paying our price, and thereby making us **holy, blameless, and without a single fault in His eyes**.

This is the gospel. **This is the Good News.**

Salvation is a **gift** we receive when we call upon Yahshua Messiah, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

The **gift** of salvation cannot be earned by our deeds, works, or fruitless self-righteous attempts at keeping the law.

We cannot obtain it by being a good person or by attending church.

Ephesians 2:8 tells us,

"God saved you by His grace when you believed, and you can't take credit for this, it is a gift from God.

Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it."

We can only receive our salvation as a **gift** from Yahshua Messiah... **'to us'**.

Everyone who calls upon the name of Yahshua **will be saved**, so call upon Him **now**, tomorrow is not assured.

Yahshua Messiah tells us **WHY** we must believe He is The Almighty Father manifested in flesh

Yahshua Messiah **Himself** tells us **why** we must believe He is the 'I AM' of Exodus 3:14; The Almighty Father come manifested in flesh.

The Almighty Father tells us that He is the only Savior

*I, I am Yahweh, **and there is no other Savior but Me.***

Isaiah 43:11

*For there is no other God but Me, a righteous God and Savior. **There is none but Me.***

Isaiah 45:21

*And you shall know no God but Me; **For there is no savior besides Me.***

Hosea 13:4

Believer, The Almighty Fathers words are clear and unmistakable; **they leave no doubt.**

The Almighty Father is **our Savior**; He is the **only Savior**.

The Almighty Father appears to Moses

When The Almighty Father appeared to Moses in the burning bush, Moses asked His name. The Almighty Father gave Moses this reply:

"I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM' has sent me to you."

Exodus 3:14

Believer, it is **unarguable** that '**I AM**' is The Almighty Father.

Ever since this name was spoken by **The Almighty Father**, the Israelites considered the name "**I AM**" to be **sacred**.

This name was not to be used in vain or bestowed on **anyone** other than **The Almighty Father Himself**.

The Gospel of John tells us that one day the Pharisees came to question Yahshua.

Yahshua responded to their questions saying,

"I tell you the truth, before Abraham was born, I AM!"

John 8:58

Here, Yahshua calls **Himself** the ancient and sacred name of The Almighty Father, '**I AM**'.

Yahshua proclaimed to the Pharisees (**and us**) that **He** was '**I AM**', **The Almighty Father** of Exodus 3:14 that they **purported** to worship.

The Pharisees became enraged when Yahshua said that **He** was '**I AM**' and they picked up stones to kill Him for blasphemy.

Sadly, there are many people today, who just like the Pharisees, **reject** our Savior's **own words** proclaiming **His identity** as being '**I AM**', **The Almighty Father who had come to them manifested in flesh**.

Yahshua tells the Pharisees (**and us**) something **VITAL**

"Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am **He**, you will die in your sins."

John 8:24

Notice the "**He**" in this verse is in italics, which means that it **was not** in the original Greek, but was **added** by the translators. The "**He**" in italics was **NOT** spoken by Yahshua. This added word completely obscures the fact that Yahshua proclaimed to the Pharisees that **He** was the '**I AM**' of the Old Testament... **The Almighty Father**. (Exodus 3:14, John 8:58).

The Greek words translated as "I am" are '**EGO EIMI**' which is, '**I AM**'.

John 8:24 is actually as follows,

"Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that **I AM**, you will die in your sins."

Thirty four verses later in John 8:58, Yahshua **emphatically repeats** His declaration that He is **I AM**, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

"Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."

What Yahshua told the Pharisees (**and us**) is clear and unambiguous, it is not open to more than one interpretation. His message is this, if you do not believe that '**I AM**', **The Almighty Father** of Exodus 3:14 **you will die in your sins**.

Believer's we must understand that when Yahshua told the Pharisees they must believe that **He** was **The Almighty Father** of Exodus 3:14 or they would die in their sins... **He was speaking to **to us** as well**.

According to Yahshua, **rightly believing who He is**, is **essential** for salvation. A 'different Jesus', or another version of Jesus, is not acceptable.

Yahshua makes it clear that for a person to be saved from sin, **they must** believe that **He is The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14 come in flesh**.


Why must this be?

The answer is because **The Almighty Father**, as **scripture states**, is **the only Savior**! The Almighty Father is the **only** one that can save someone from their sins; **there is no other Savior**! Thus, if a person does not believe that Yahshua is **The Almighty Father and only Savior**, they will die in their sins.

Today, people engage in **intellectual debates** about who the Father is. Is our Savior the Father; is our Savior a 'second person' in the Trinity Doctrine? But Yahshua is having none of it, He speaks clearly and truthfully to those who will listen. **He is I AM**, and no debating or intellectualizing will change that. No man, tradition or denomination **will change that**.

The Trinity Doctrine's '**I AM**' Problem

Scriptures **unarguably** show that **I AM is The Almighty Father**. Scriptures **unarguably** show that Yahshua said **He** was **I AM**. The Trinity Doctrine however, states "The Father is **NOT** the Son" and "The Son is **NOT** the Father". Therefore, according to the Trinity Doctrine, **it is not possible** for Yahshua to be '**I AM**' because **Yahshua is the Son**; He is **NOT** the Father.
