

John 1:34 - The Almighty Father in Human Flesh

*“And I have seen and testified that this is the **Son** of God.”*

John the Baptist... John 1:34

When John the Baptist said, “*this is the **Son** of God*”, referring to Yahshua Messiah, he was **not** speaking of a **parent-child relationship**. John was telling us this is The Almighty Father in **human** form.

The word “Son” in John 1:34, is a ‘**Semitic Idiom**’ used in the Jewish culture to denote ‘**a human**’.

John was **not** saying, ‘this is the ‘**offspring**’ of The Almighty Father’.

John was saying, **this is The Almighty Father in human flesh**.

The word Son used in John 1:34 a Semitic Idiom

‘**Semitic Idiom**’ Explanation

In John 1:34, the term "Son" is indeed used as a Semitic idiom which means ‘a human being’ and is not referring to a parent-child relationship.

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
