
The Bible says there is but one God, the Father

*yet for us there is but **one God, the Father**,
from whom are all things and we exist for Him;
and one Lord, Jesus Christ, by whom are all
things, and we exist through Him.*

1 Corinthians 8:6

***one God and Father** of all,
who is above all, and through all, and in you all.*
Ephesians 4:5-6

*Have we not all **one Father**?
Has not **one God** created us?*
Malachi 2:10

The Bible tells us there is **one God, the Father**.
Because we **know** that Yahshua is God, we
know that **He** is The Almighty Father who
manifested **Himself** in flesh to be our Savior
(**“there is but one God, the Father”**).

The Father tells us that **He** is the **only Savior**.
Therefore, we **know** that Yahshua Messiyah **is**
The Almighty Father manifested in flesh; **for we**
know Yahshua is the only Savior.

Yahshua proclaims He is “I AM”

In the Old Testament The Almighty Father
declares **He** is “I AM”. (Exodus 3:14)

In the New Testament, Yahshua declares that **He**
is “I AM”.

When Yahshua states that He is “I AM”, He is
proclaiming that **He** is The Almighty Father of
Exodus 3:14 now come **manifested in flesh!**

**Yahshua makes an explicit declaration
in John 8:24**

“Therefore I said to you that you will die in your
sins; for if you do not believe that I am (*He*),
you will die in your sins.”

The (*He*) in italics was **NOT** spoken by Yahshua.
This **added** word by translators completely
obscures the fact that Yahshua proclaimed **He**
was the “**I AM**” of the Old Testament (Exodus
3:14, John 8:58).

John 8:24 is actually as follows,

*“Therefore I said to you that you will die in
your sins; for if you do not believe that **I AM**,
you will die in your sins.”*

Yahshua declares in John 8:24 that a person who
wants cleansing from sin **must believe** that **He** is
the ‘**I AM**’ of the Old Testament; The Almighty
Father manifested in flesh.

According to Yahshua, **rightly understanding** and
believing who He is, is essential for salvation.

Why must a person believe that Yahshua is **I AM**,
The Almighty Father of Exodus 3:14?

The answer is simple. It is because The Almighty
Father, as scripture states, **is the only Savior!**
The Almighty Father is the **only one** that can
save someone from their sins.

Therefore, it is **eternally important** we **believe**
and proclaim that our Savior Yahshua Messiyah
is ‘**I AM**’, The Almighty Father manifested in flesh.

**“for if you do not believe that I AM,
you will die in your sins.”**

**Yahshua said,
“The true worshipers
will worship the Father”**

**Yahshua welcomes and
accepts worship**

*“But the hour is coming, and now is,
when **the true worshipers**
will worship **the Father**
in spirit and truth”*

John 4:23

According to Yahshua, **“The true worshipers
will worship the Father.”**

Scriptures show people **worshiped** Yahshua.

Even from His birth **Yahshua was worshiped!**

*Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem
of Judea in the days of Herod the king,
behold, wise men from the East came
to Jerusalem, saying,*

*“Where is He who has been born
King of the Jews?*

*For we have seen His star in the East and
have come **to worship Him**.”*

*And when they had come into the house,
they saw the young Child with Mary His mother,
and fell down and worshiped Him.*

Matthew 2:2, 11

Yahshua was worshiped when He was a baby.

Yahshua was worshiped by His disciples.

Yahshua was worshiped by everyday people.

Yahshua was worshiped by demon possessed people.

Yahshua was worshiped by the apostles.

Yahshua was worshiped after His resurrection.

In every instance, Yahshua welcomed and accepted worship!

Scriptures show not only that Yahshua was **worshiped**, but that He **welcomed** and **accepted** worship.

Matthew 8:2

*And behold, a leper came and **worshiped Him**, saying, "Lord if You are willing, You can make me clean." Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, I am willing; be cleansed.*

Matthew 9:18

*While He spoke these things to them, behold, a ruler came and **worshiped Him**, saying, "My daughter has just died, but come and lay Your hand on her and she will live."*

Matthew 15:25

*Then she came and **worshiped Him**, saying, "Lord, help me!"*

Mark 5:6

*When he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and **worshiped Him**.*

John 9:38

*Then he said, "Lord, I believe!" And he **worshiped Him**.*

Thomas worshiped Yahshua when he saw Him alive again.

And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"

John 20:28

Two memorable examples of Yahshua accepting worship occurred just after His resurrection when "Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb."

*So they departed quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to bring His disciples word. And as they went to tell His disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, "Rejoice!" So they came and held Him by the feet and **worshiped Him**.*

Matthew 28:8-9

Yahshua is The Almighty Father manifested in flesh

"God was manifested in the flesh" 1 Tim 3:16

*Notice: The Apostle Paul does **not say** God's 'son' was manifested in the flesh.*

Yahshua said, "**The true worshipers** will worship **the Father** in spirit and truth."

Let us too, like those in the Bible before us, worship Yahshua in **spirit and truth**.

"Prepare the way for Yahweh"

The Prophet John the Baptist (*and according to Yahshua, the **greatest prophet** who ever lived*) preached this message:

*"Prepare the way for **Yahweh**" (Yahweh **is the Father!**)*

We know that John the Baptist is speaking about **Yahshua Messiyah!**

This is why the apostle Paul called Yahshua...

*"our great **God** and **Savior**." Titus 2:13*

This is why the apostle Peter said...

*"To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our **God** and **Savior** Jesus Christ" 2 Peter 1:1*

This is why Jude said...

*To **God our Savior**, Who alone is wise, Be glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Jude 25*

The Almighty Father is the only Savior

Scriptures clearly tell us there is **no** Savior but The Almighty Father. (Isaiah 43:11; Isaiah 45:21; Hosea 13:4)

Furthermore, it is The Almighty Father **Himself** who tells us that **He** is the **only Savior!**

*I, I am Yahweh, and there is **no** other Savior but **Me**. Isaiah 43:11*

*And you shall know no God but me; For there is **no** savior **besides Me**. Hosea 13:4*
