
These are the important issues regarding our Saviors name

The Almighty Father gave clear instructions,

*“You, shall call His name **Yahshua**”*

1. The Almighty Father had a **purpose** for sending an angel and giving these instructions to Yosef. The Almighty Father wanted His Old Testament name **YAH**, to **remain** His name in the New Testament!

2. The names ‘Jesus’ and ‘Yeshua’ **completely eliminate** The Almighty Fathers name.

3. Because the names ‘Jesus’ and ‘Yeshua’ **eliminate** the Fathers name, **they have eliminated His identity** as being **our Savior**.

4. Using the names ‘Jesus’ and ‘Yeshua’, people can no longer easily **identify** that **YAH, The Almighty Father** is in fact our Savior... **for the identity of our Savior is found in His name!**

5. Because the names ‘Jesus’ and ‘Yeshua’ have **removed** The Almighty Fathers name, He has been **robbed** of the **glory** that belongs to **Him** as being **our Savior**.

I do not believe these issues are trivial. I believe these are **great wrongs** that need to be **made right** by **this** generation of Believers. I hope **you** believe these issues are **meaningful** and **important** too.

What **now** are we to do with our new given knowledge?

I’m reminded of a time I mistakingly called someone I had met by a name not their own. This person very politely told me what their name **actually** was (*I guess all of us desire to be called by our real name*). Anyway, from that moment on I always called him **by his true name**.

The Almighty Father manifested Himself in flesh as a man, to do **for us** what we could **NEVER** do for ourselves. He fulfilled the demands of the Law **as a perfect man of flesh**, so that **He** could be **our perfect sacrifice** and **‘kinsman-redeemer’!**



The Almighty Father tells us in Isaiah 43:11
*“there is no other Savior but **Me**.”*

On the cross He took **ALL** of our sins (**past, present and future**) and put them upon **Himself**, paying **our** price and thereby making us **“holy, blameless”** and **“without a single fault”** in His eyes. (Colossians 1:22)

This is the gospel! **This is the Good News!**

Salvation is a **gift** for you

Salvation is a **gift** we receive when we call upon Yahshua MessiYah, **The Almighty Father manifested in flesh**. The **gift** of salvation cannot be **earned** by our deeds, works or fruitless **self-righteous** attempts at ‘keeping the Law’. We cannot obtain it by being a “good person” or by attending church.

We can only receive our salvation **as a gift** from Yahshua MessiYah... **to us**.

Everyone who calls upon the name of Yahshua will be saved, so call upon Him now. Tomorrow is not assured

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Yahshua or Yeshua?

Some people say that **‘YAH’** is the shortened or abbreviated form of The Almighty Father’s name, but that is **not** correct. **YAH is** the name of The Almighty Father.

King David tells us clearly in Psalm 68:4 that The Almighty Father’s name is **‘YAH’**.

*Sing to God, sing praises to His name;
Extol Him who rides on the clouds,
By His name **YAH**,
And rejoice before Him.*

The prophet Isaiah tells us The Almighty Father’s name is **‘YAH’** in Isaiah 12:2.

*Behold, God is my salvation,
I will trust and not be afraid;
‘For **YAH**, the LORD, is my strength and song;
He also has become my salvation.’*

In Revelation 19:1-6, the multitudes are saying Hallelu-**YAH**, which means “Praise **YAH**”.

The Scriptures tell us there is **only one Savior, The Almighty Father** (Isaiah 43:11; Isaiah 45:21; Hosea 13:4).

The Almighty Father (the only Savior) waited until He came to us in person to give us His highest name; *“the name which is above every name”*, **YAH-shua**. (Philippians 2:9)

In Hebrew, the name **YAH-shua** means, **‘YAH is salvation’**.

When **The Almighty Father** came to us **Himself** as our Messiyah (**The Father in a human body**), He made certain that His name '**YAH**' would follow **Him**. The Almighty Father **did not allow men** to choose **His** name.

Specific instructions were given to Yosef ...

*"you shall call His name **Yahshua**."*

The angel bringing Yosef this message did not speak to Yosef in English, Latin or Greek, but spoke to him in his own language... **Hebrew**.

When the time came for the '**invisible**' Father of the Old Testament to come into the world manifested in flesh, He had already **made sure** via Yosef that His name in the **Old** Testament, **would remain** His name in the **New** Testament... **YAH!**

The Almighty Father waited to give us His **highest** name until He came to us **Himself**, to shed His blood for us and to be our perfect sacrifice for sin. This is why the name **Yahshua**, is **the name above all names!**

Men give The Almighty Father a new 'Hellenized' name... '**Jesus**'

Against the Father's instructions, men did end up choosing the Savior's name after all.

After many **needless** translations / transliterations of the Hebrew name '**Yahshua**', our Savior was given a new 'Hellenized' name... '**Jesus**'.

This new 'Hellenized' name removed all traces of '**Jewishness**' from the Saviors original Hebrew name. (*Yosef and Miryam got new 'Hellenized' names too; they were now 'Joseph' and 'Mary'*).

Shamefully, the new name '**Jesus**', also **completely removed** The Almighty Father's **name, YAH!**

It is important for us to understand the meaning of these names

YAH YAH-weh YAH-shua

These are names of The Almighty Father

YAH - is the Almighty Father's name. (Psalm 68:4; Isaiah 12:2; Revelation 19:1-6) In Revelation, the people are shouting Hallelu**YAH**, which means "**Praise YAH**"

YAH-weh and YAH-shua are compound names of The Almighty Father

YAH-weh - is a **compound name**. It is The Almighty Father's name with a 'descriptor' **added**. The descriptor '**weh**' means, 'The Self-Existent one' (**I AM**). **YAH-weh** means, '**YAH** - The Self-Existent one'.

YAH-shua - is a **compound name**. In the New Testament, **YAH** now combines His name with His **highest** descriptor '**shua**', which means '**is salvation**'. **YAH-shua** means, '**YAH is Salvation**'. This is the name **above every name!** (Philippians 2:9)

Why 'Yeshua' is not the Saviors name

Our Savior **Himself** tells us His name is **Yahshua**, not 'Yeshua' in John 17:11.

*...keep them in **Your name**, the name which **You have given Me**...*

Many scriptures in the Bible can be found proclaiming **The Almighty Father's** name is **YAH**, but **there are no scriptures** proclaiming His name is 'Ye'. The people in Heaven are shouting Hallelu**YAH**, they are **not** shouting Hallelu**Ye**.

The name 'Yeshua', like the name 'Jesus', **completely eliminates** The Almighty Fathers name.

Both the names 'Jesus' and 'Yeshua', **rob** The Almighty Father of **His name, His identity** and the **glory** that is **due Him alone** as being **our Savior**.

We **know** from scripture the Fathers name is **YAH**, not Ye. Because the Almighty's name is **YAH**, the name 'Yeshua' is not only incorrect, it **removes** the Almighty's name altogether!

"To remove the name is to extinguish the person"

"In the Scriptures there is the closest possible relationship between a person and his name, the two being practically equivalent, so that to remove the name is to extinguish the person.

*To forget God's name **is to depart from Him**."*
